Digital Inland Waterway Area

- One out of 10 Juncker priorities: Digital Single Market Strategy¹
- Interconnect information on infrastructure, people, vessels, management, operations and cargo
- Improve data gathering through smart, monitoring-enabled components and actors
- ITS-enabled tools for operations and management
- Interconnection with ITS systems of other modes of transport

Revision of the four RIS standards Next steps (1/2)

- Final discussions on the RIS standards by the Expert Groups during this week
- Receipt by DG MOVE in Dec 2015
- Preparation for adoption process will be launched beginning of 2016

Revision of the four RIS standards Next steps (2/2)

Steps ahead:

- Preliminary review DG MOVE
- Preparation according to Better Regulation Communication¹
- Formal consultation of all the services within the European Commission
- Translation
- Launching the adoption

European Hull Database (EHDB)

- Currently operated in subcontracted mode -> EC plans to insource operations of the EHDB
- Preparations ongoing to take over by 3/2016
fallback scenario with take over by 3/2017
- Preparation of legal and technical migration plans - ongoing
- EHDB Steering Committee meetings 24/11/2015 & 3/2/2016

European Reference Data Management System (ERDMS)

- Currently operated in subcontracted mode -> EC plans to insource operations of the ERDMS
- Preparations ongoing to take over by 3/2016
fallback scenario with take over by 3/2017
- Preparation of technical migration plans and legal aspects - ongoing
- Steering Committee of ERDMS to be established -> written communication by the EC to MS

RIS CEF Call 2015

RIS Actions can generally consist of the following:

- Works
- Studies
- Studies with pilot activities¹
- Combination of studies and works and pilots

Funding available under General Call and cohesion call:

- 10 M € General Call
- 10 M € Cohesion Call

Co-funding rates:

- Up to 85 % under Cohesion Call
- Up to 50% for land-based components and 20% for on-board components under the General Call

RIS CEF Call 2015 Objectives

Deploy harmonised RIS (on-board and land-based) components to support traffic and transport management in inland navigation to:

1. Complete the implementation of the RIS Directive
2. Implement outcome of successful studies & pilots carried out under previous projects
3. Develop further RIS services and applications with a focus on safety and in particular on i) **tangible benefits for inland navigation actors and users**, and ii) **better integration of inland navigation into the transport logistic chain**

Ongoing projects (selected)

Finishing soon:

- CoRISma (TEN-T) - to facilitate RIS enabled IWT Corridor Management
- PLATINA II project (7RFP) - to support the implementation of Naiades II)

Ongoing

- Prominent (H2020) – green concepts and technologies for European Inland Shipping and electronic tools for qualifications
- FAIRway Danube (CEF) – preparing the harmonized rehabilitation of the Danube and its navigable tributaries

Contracts (selected)

'Running':

- Support to RIS expert groups
- Provision and maintenance of RIS support tools (ERDMS, EHDB, IEHG)

To be signed in 2015

- CEF Programme Support Action / DINA
- Provision and maintenance of RIS support tools (prolongation of IEHG and related advisory activities)

Selected CEF PSA's – useful synergies with RIS implementation

- Towards Digital Inland Waterway Area and Digital Multimodal Nodes: elaboration of DINA, support to RIS expert groups, hosting of RIS portal
- Innovation facilitation for inland waterway operations: network of IWT innovation centres
- Data collection on the trans-European transport network (TEN-T network) using the TENtec system
